
Cut two 9" squares from background/solid fabric. Cut each square on the diagonal to yield Half Square Triangles (HST).





Mark each HST as shown.

Draw a line between marks as shown below.







Spiderweb Block

12" finished block

Gather scraps of various sizes and cut into strips. Strips should range from 1 1/4" to 2" in width and 5 1/2" to 2" in length.


Place first strip right sides together matching one edge to the penciled line. Sew in place. Fold back and Press.




Place the second strip right sides together over the first strip. Sew in place. Fold back and Press.


Continue sewing in this manner to complete the piecing on one end of the HST. Repeat for the opposite end of the HST.

Flip HST face down and trim using the foundation piece as a guide. Make four.











Sew two HSTs together. Press. Repeat. Sew the two completed sections together to make the block.
